Three *entry points* to our Distance Learning Program:

- 1. *You elect distance learning for your child.
- 2. Your child is ineligible for in-person learning (virus exposure, quarantine, etc.) but is feeling fine to engage in learning at home.

- A supportive partnership

- Desk & chair supportive of class participation (sitting or standing)
- A place for basic school supplies (paper, pencil, other as indicated by your classroom teacher)






The Schenck School Teaching & Learning during the 2020 - 2021 School Year
